1. Name 3 things you remember and love about your mom if you are able?
2. Why do you think God called Mary "highly favored?" (Luke 1.28).
3. Read the following verses and comment on the significance of Jesus' mom being at these events.
1 John 2.1 "On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there"
John 19.25 "Therefore the soldiers did these things. But standing by the cross of Jesus were His mother."
4. Mary was with Jesus a lot. Do you remember other times that Mary was with Jesus?
5. Read Luke 1.26-38 together and observe on this amazing announcement.
6. Mary yielded to the Father's will. What are some challenges to that? Some she knew but did not know?
7. When we fully yield to the Lord in areas (missions, giving, quitting something, etc.) what are some of our challenges?
8. Why is being a servant so important in our faith? Where/what/How do you serve now or others you have observed that are servants.
9. Verses on Serving. Mark 9.35 (ESV)
³⁵And he sat down and called the twelve. And he said to them, "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all."
