1. Read Galatians 5.16-26 together.
2. Read through the works of the flesh? Read vs 17. Why do these desires conflict with the Spirit? Which ones are most painful to our society? Families? Marriages? Personal worth?
3. How has the first three changed our society in the last 50 years? How has our society suffered because of the changes?
4. The flesh is not our sinful nature, we as believers no longer have a nature to sin, and its not natural, but the desires of flesh rage against us. In this text how does Paul instruct us to be people of the fruit of the Spirit? (see v18 and v. 24).
5. Read Galatians 2:20. This is how Paul did it. Thoughts?
6. Read the fruit of the Spirit in verses 22-23. Which of these are difficult for you personally and how is God growing you in these.
7. All of these fruit deal with love. They are all about the love of Jesus for God is love. Read 1 Cor. 13 and talk about the definitions for love?
8. How does God's definition of love clash with worldly definitions or beliefs about love?
9. We are to "live by the Spirit and walk by the Spirit." How can we do that? What are keys you have found? How do we be filled with more of God's Spirit?
