1. Read John 3.1-8

2. Pastor talked about being “born-again”. Some of you share your born-again experience? Who led you to Christ? How did you know you needed to be saved?

3. Pastor taught that we live in the Kingdom of God now. What does living in God’s Kingdom now mean? How does that make our life different from others? What changes does that require?

4. What is the difference between a new life and a new religion?

5. When you were born again, what was new in your life (Read John 6.63).

John 6:63 (NASB95)

⁶³“It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.

6. Read Ephesians 1:7–8 (NASB95)

⁷In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

⁸which He lavished on us. In all wisdom and insight

Pastor said that Jesus came to forgive us when we are born-again, but to remove sin from our life. What do you think this means? Why does Christ want sin removed from life now? How does this happen. (See 1 John 1.9).

7. Read Colossians 1:13 (NASB95)

“For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

Why do you think not being saved is always referred to as “darkness?”

8. Read John 3:16-18 Talk about these verses and the truths that are in them.

9. Pastor always refers to Romans 8.29 “We are predestined to be conformed into the image of His Son” In light of your being “born again” and being changed, what are some ways that God is changing you to be more like Jesus.
