Revelation 3.7-13

Who Jesus is (not tendencies, but his very essence).

- Jesus is true.
- Jesus is Holy
- Jesus is the authority (Isaiah 22:20–23, NASB95)

"Then it will come about in that day, that I will summon my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah, and I will clothe him with your tunic and tie your sash securely about him. I will entrust him with your authority, and he will become a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. "Then I will set the key of the house of David on his shoulder, When he opens no one will shut, When he shuts no one will open. "I will drive him like a peg in a firm place, and he will become a throne of glory to his father's house."

What Jesus Knows

1. He knows their works.

Works are their ministries, activities for Christ.

2. He has given them an "open door".

Opportunities to minister Christ

Opportunities now.

- 3. No one can shut a door that Jesus opens
- 4. That have "little strength" but that does not mean week. Their strength was real.

Sometimes you need just a little

- 5. They have kept His word, and not denied Jesus.
- 6. He is coming Quickly Hold fast to your crown.

Be an Overcomer

"'He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name." (Revelation 3:12, NASB95)

- We will become pillars in the house (not a weight)
- Write on us the name of God, city, the address (Where you belong, and whose we are).
