2. Read John 16.33, Make some observations as you read it a couple times.
3. Talk about the promises? What are they?
4. What tribulations will we face? What have you faced in life?
5. Describe a time when you were overwhelmed by the peace of God.
6. How did Jesus overcome the world?
7. Why is the cross so powerful in us being overcomers? What do we receive because of the cross?
8. What did Paul have to overcome (2 Corinthians 11. 23-33)?
9. How did he become an overcomer?
10. Read this verse:

“Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, “Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. “And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.”
(Revelation 12:10–11, NASB95)

NOTES: Living an overcoming Life

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What is an overcomer?

I believe God wants us to be Overcomers.

I believe Christ has given us the power to be overcomers.

I believe Jesus Christ is the example of being an overcomer.

John 14-16

““These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world.”” (John 16:33, NASB95)

What in your life would you love to be an overcomer?

Moses, Abraham, David, Job, Jonah, Gideon, John the Baptist, Peter, Paul

2 Corinthians 11.23-33 Paul had to overcome a lot for what Jesus had called him to do.

1. Know that our victory was purchased at the cross.

- *“For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.” (1 Corinthians 2:2, NASB95)*
- *“For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 1:18, NASB95)*

You can't be an overcomer if you are participating in things that Christ died for us to overcome.

2. Give your whole life to God

Be 100% committed of Christ, Don't compromise, don't feel ok about continuing to sin

Don't give the Devil a foothold in your life

You will never overcome the grip of this world if you're holding on to parts of it.

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
