Colossians 1. 9-14

All through Scriptures, the Scriptures are declared to be the basis and foundation for being filled with the knowledge of God.

Romans 10:17 (NASB95) — 17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

Hebrews 4:12 (NASB95) — 12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Psalms 119:11 (NASB95) — 11 Your word I have treasured in my heart, That I may not sin against You.

How do we get filled with the Knowledge of God? First we must know that God is knowable. We will never understand everything about God, but we are on a quest to be filled with knowledge of his will and ways.

God is Knowable

1. God has revealed Himself to us so we can know Him.

Romans 1:18–20

- a) His Invisible attributes (his character as seen in Jesus- Colossians 1.15)
- b) His eternal power (seen in physical creation)
- c) His Divine nature (seen in his acts and motives of creation)
- d) Our Conscience (God has also revealed Himself through the spirit, or mind, of humanity)

2. God has been revealed in Christ.

Colossians 1:15–20

Hebrews 1:1–2 (NASB95) — 1 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, **2** in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

3. God has revealed Himself in our own personal experience and salvation.

- Personal knowledge comes from personal experience and that starts at salvation.
- III- we know something but when we experience we really know it.

4. God has revealed Himself in the Bible

2 Timothy 3:16 (NASB95) — 16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;

To be filled with the knowledge of His will, we must learn His ways and His ways are given to us in His Word
