FOCUS

Ice Breaker: What are some of the funniest memories you have of taking pictures or having pictures taken?

1. Focus is defined as “the things that draw our attention.” What are the things in your life that draw most of your time and attention?
2. Read Colossians 3:1. What is Paul is telling Christians to focus on? Is this always what you focus on? What are some things that draw our focus in the life of a Christian?
3. What are the “realities of heaven” that Paul is referring to in verse 1?
4. Read Colossians 2:20-23. What was the focus of the church that Paul was addressing in this letter? Can you relate? As a Christian, have you ever been focused on your behavior, instead of Christ?
5. Read Colossians 3:2-3. How can we think of the realities of heaven when we live in this world? What do you think Paul means?
6. We often focus on what to crop out of our lives. If we focus on our struggles and not Christ, we will feel defeated all the time. How can we grow as a Christian, without focusing on our sins and failures?
7. Read Colossians 3:4. What is the source of your life? What is the constant thing that sustains you and drives you?
8. Close in prayer. Ask God to give you and your Small Group a newfound FOCUS on Him and the realities of heaven. Pray over everyone that they would be transformed by a shift of focus and truth in Christ.
